

## 100 YARD RANGE RULES

1. A 100 yard range safety officer must be present to shoot 100 yards.
2. The 100 yard range hours are from 12pm to dusk on non federal holiday Mondays. The 25/50 yard ranges close at 11:30am.
3. Cars must be parked on the 100 yard end of the range.
4. The yellow chain **MUST** be hung across the road and the “100 yard in use “sign must be hung on the entrance gate before the range goes HOT.
5. The main gate must be locked with a lock only the range safety officer has a key to.
6. Everyone must be at or behind the firing line when the range is hot.
7. The range safety officer will ask shooters if they have sighted in their firearms from 25/50 yards to insure they can safely shoot from 100 yards.
8. Shots may be fired from inside or outside the 100 yard house.
  
10. The 100 yard RSO, upon hearing/seeing a member wanting to gain access to the range will make the range cold and signal that information to the member wanting entrance. The RSO will also unlock the gate if the member is not a 100 yard RSO. The 100 yard RSO is not a doorman for incoming members.
